Treasurer's Report:

The monthly financial statements as presented by Tim were accepted. A motion was approved to transfer \$2,500 from The Bremerton Kiwanis Club Foundation Account to the Project Account.

As minutes from previous meetings were not available they will be submitted for consideration at a future board meeting.

Old Business:

Rob reported a net income of \$3,001.00 from the Golf Tournament.

New Business:

Darroll Clark submitted Alyson Rotter's application for membership. She is employed at the Olympic Educational Service District 114 Office and is a Bremerton School Board Member. After discussion her application was approved.
